JORDAN COVE OPEN HOUSE: MARCH 27, 2012

Jordan Cove Energy invites the public to the Mill Casino/Hotel in North Bend for an open house on March 27th. The doors will be open from 4pm to 8:30 pm. This Open House is being held in order to present the changes to the Project resulting from adding export capability to it's presently FERC authorized Import Certification. Key staff members for the Project will be available to answer any questions concerning the project.

Much has changed in in the natural gas industry in the past several years. North American natural gas supplies have increased due to cutting-edge technologies opening new opportunities. Countries in the Pacific Basin are now seeking US natural gas as a stable source of energy.

U.S. shipping and trucking companies are changing their fleets to natural gas power. Natural gas is much cheaper and cleaner than some traditional fuels. The emergence of the natural gas industry has also created American jobs.

Jordan Cove Energy Project has redirected its efforts to assist in meeting this demand in emerging markets. Jordan Cove Energy Project is now adding exporting capability from the terminal on the North Spit in Coos County.

This open house will present new and updated information addressing various aspects of the facility, its construction and operation. Presentations will revolve around changes made to the facility, safety and security, tsunami planning, required training, and potential community impacts and benefits.

Staff from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC), the lead federal agency responsible for authorizing liquefied natural gas facilities, will be present at the open house to answer questions regarding the FERC's environmental review process.
