# Coos County

## A Booming Local Economy



### Thousands of jobs for Southern Oregon

- 6,000 construction jobs
- 8,500 spinoff jobs each year of construction
- 215 permanent family wage jobs
- 1,500 spinoff local jobs after start-up
- Continuous maritime and tourism jobs from 110 new ship visits per year



### Lasting economic boost to local businesses

- \$70 million in annual spending from workers for local businesses during construction
- \$29.5 million in annual local spending from workers during operations
- Each ship call to the port generates \$1 million in economic benefit
- 110 new vessel calls per year will increase port traffic by 300%, providing for regularly maintaining the federal channel and safe bar crossing

## A Better Place to Live, Work and Raise a Family



### Contributing to a safer, modernized port

- Contributing to navigation improvements
- Improving jetty maintenance and a safer bar crossing for all vessels
- Minimal impacts to recreational and commercial use and access



### Creating living wage jobs in Coos County

- Average 493 FTE jobs each year during four-year construction period
- 177 local living wage careers after start-up



### Committing \$100 million to environmental mitigation and restoration

- Restoring 100 acres of fresh and saltmarsh wetlands for prime Coho habitat
- Providing environmental and cultural education for students and visitors



### Investments in local infrastructure and services

- \$2.8 million each year to our public schools
- More than \$300,000 each year for community colleges
- More than \$350,000 each year for libraries
- More than \$280,000 each year in tax revenue to local fire districts, the equivalent of paying five new firefighters
- Over \$600,000 each year to county government and infrastructure



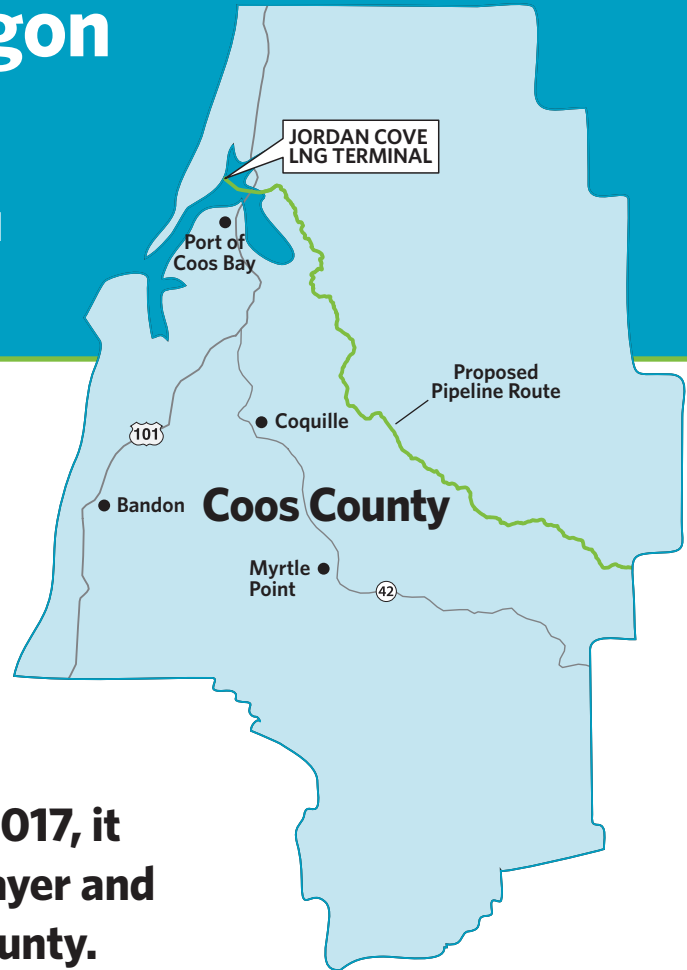
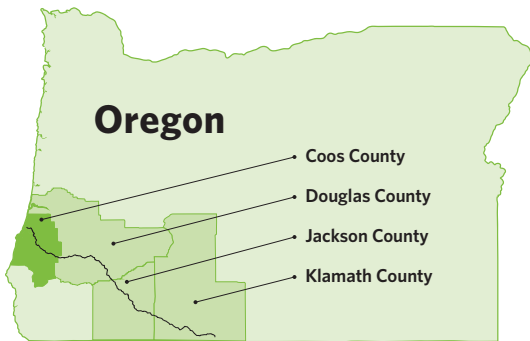
### More than \$500 million to the Community Enhancement Plan (CEP)

- Directing Enterprise Zone tax savings to local governments immediately
- Keeping tax revenues local
- Building a long-term business in Southern Oregon and working with local leaders to ensure communities benefit

# A \$10 Billion Investment in Oregon

**\$2.88 billion** spent directly with Oregon businesses.

**Approximately \$1.5 billion** in payroll to Oregon workers.



**If Jordan Cove was operating in 2017, it would be the single largest tax payer and source of public funds in Coos County. We would have received:**

## **\$40 million in new tax revenues from the LNG terminal**

- Coos Bay School Bond Measure may have been funded by the CEP
- Public safety and our jail would be funded and fully operational
- Many of our county roads and bridges would be safely repaired and improved

## **\$4.6 million in annual taxes from the pipeline**

- More than \$3,200,000 for public schools and education
- More than \$455,000 to health and public safety
- More than \$945,000 toward economic development, urban renewal, and other local government needs.
